Location

Øksnehallen, Kødbyen: 50 m from Copenhagen Central Station, 15 minutes by train from Copenhagen Airport.

Audience

- 800 professional visitors expected, mainly Nordic (both days)
- 800 private visitors expected (Sunday 14:00–18:00)

Services

- All trade-fair services (table, cooling, light catering) included
- Wine sample shipment available at additional cost
- State-of-the-art digital visitor register and matchmaking function

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Schedule

Three days structured to improve your chances of making the right contacts in the Scandinavian market.

Saturday – Big Bottle Party

The Big Bottle Party is the informal opening of the Cool Climate Wine Summit. Bring a magnum, work the room, pour samples, and meet specially invited guests to arrange table appointments for the days that follow.

Sunday – B2B & B2C

The busiest day of the fair welcomes not only leading Scandinavian importers but also around 800 private visitors, who join in the afternoon. A good opportunity to take B2C orders (we handle the administration) and to promote your winery as a travel destination.

Monday – B2B only

This day is open to professional visitors only, and attendance is weighted towards gastronomy and hotels. Traditionally calmer, but it allows for deeper discussions. Arrange your meetings beforehand and bring your laptop to fill the gaps with admin work.





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Location & Programme

Øksnehallen is a listed cattle market hall from 1901, in the Copenhagen Meatpacking District, 50 m from Central Station. [Link to Location on Google Maps.](#)

Table Set-up

Table set-up is by country, then by region, unless otherwise agreed with groups of winemakers or quality associations. Every exhibitor receives the same presentation space, measuring [TABLE DIMENSIONS].

Sparkling Wine Lounge

The Sparkling Wine Lounge is an additional space where you can present selected sparkling wines. The cost is 50 EUR net per sparkling wine. The lounge is staffed throughout both trade fair days.

No/Low Zone

The No/Low Zone is a self-tasting area where you can present your non-alcoholic and low-alcohol products. The cost is 25 EUR net per product.

Master Class Programme

The Cool Climate Wine Summit is accompanied by an international master class programme led by Masters of Wine, Master Sommeliers and other international speakers. You can apply to enter a wine after signing up. The cost is 300 EUR net per wine.

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Audience

The 2027 edition expects 800 professional and 800 private visitors over two days. As an exhibitor you receive the visitor list before the event and can invite visitors to meet you (matchmaking).

Danish Top Professionals

The Cool Climate Wine Summit Copenhagen is a fixture for Danish wine professionals. More than 100 Danish importers, sommeliers from Michelin-starred restaurants, wine educators and wine writers attend in order to meet winemakers directly.

Scandinavian Top Professionals

Copenhagen sits 30 minutes from Malmö and is directly connected to Oslo, Stockholm and Hamburg, so the Cool Climate Wine Summit is a practical meeting point for Nordic wine professionals. Our selected buyers programme brings key buyers to the event to meet boutique wineries.

Committed Private Wine Lovers

The Cool Climate Wine Summit allows selected private wine lovers to join the fair on Sunday afternoon. Ticket prices are deliberately high and the day is a Sunday, which selects for a small, engaged and knowledgeable consumer audience.





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Services and Pricing

Trade Fair Related Services

- Table and chair; exhibitor break area
- Coffee, croissant and light lunch for two people, both days
- One ice bowl, 5 kg ice per day, fridge access
- Glassware (Stölzle Lausitz) and spittoon service

Sample Shipment

Samples for the fair can be shipped in advance through our wine logistics partner WMS (ProWein, Rolling Pin, VDP.Weinbörse). The shipment service is charged separately.
